Meetings:

An Annual Membership meeting is held during the month of March of each year

Fees:

Regular dues currently are \$230 per month for each Unit homeowner

Insurance assessments are pro-rated to each Unit and are expected to average about \$1,500 annually in April for building casualty (shell) and general liability insurance on the common area.

Services:

The Association provides:

- 1. Routine maintenance of the exterior and fencing of each townhome which consists of repair and replacement of surface sheathing and trim but not structure, doors or windows,
- 2. Painting of the exterior of each building,
- 3. Repair and replacement of roofs,
- 4. Paving and repair of private roads,
- 5. Repair and replacement of driveways,
- 6. Street lighting,
- 7. Lawn treatment, irrigation and maintenance of the common area grounds,
- 8. Tree and major planting management,
- 9. Termite treatment of the perimeter of all buildings,
- 10. Biannual pest control spraying of exterior entryways to homes,
- 11. Association legal and accounting services,
